Overlocker Basics 1 10 – 2.30pm	Learn basic machine maintenance, 4 versus 3 threads, stitch length and width, threading, tensions, differential feed, roll hemming, and trouble shooting.	Wed 10 Feb, Mon 8 Mar, or Fri 19 Mar.	\$75
Overlocker Basics 2 10 – 2.30pm	An extension to Overlocker basics 1. Learn overlocker sewing techniques; corners and curves, fluted and lettuce edges, gathering, piping, elastic and lace insertion, and pintucks. Extra feet are required for this class.	Wed 24 Feb, or Mon 22 Mar.	\$75
Foot Day 10 – 2.30pm	Bring in and discover what all your accessory feet are for. Other feet will also be demonstrated that make sewing easier and more enjoyable.	Wed 10 Mar.	\$75
